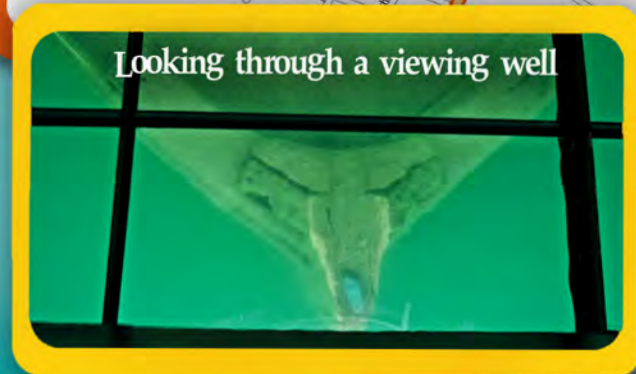
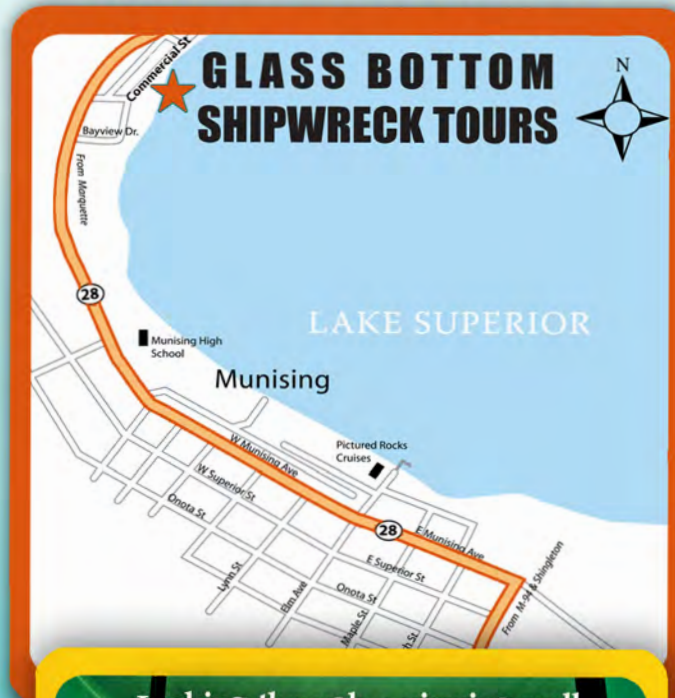

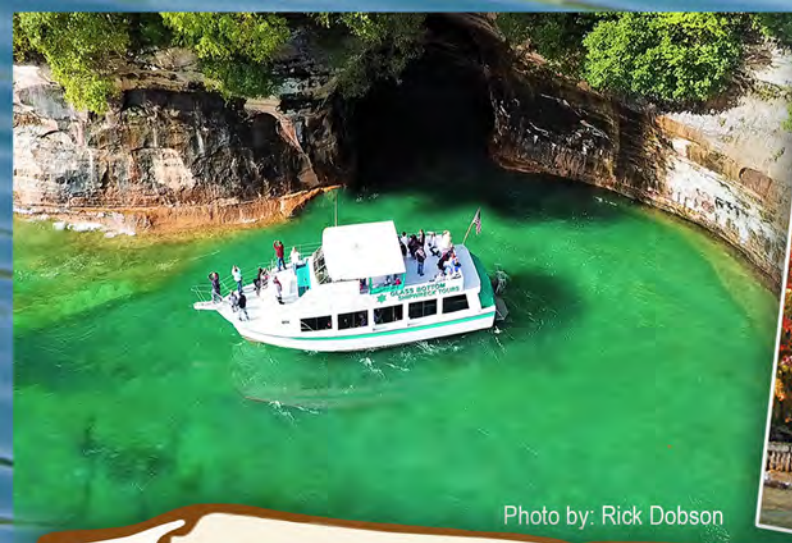

## Maritime History:

The iron ore boom of the mid 1800s spurred the construction of thousands of wooden ships to carry iron ore and other cargoes throughout the great lakes. Bad weather and difficult navigation routes caused thousands of ships to wreck on a scale more extreme than anywhere else on the planet. As most shipwrecks are in deep water, our tour highlights two vessels that lie just below the surface. The "Bermuda", a fully intact wooden schooner built in 1860, passes within 8 feet of our viewing glass, and the "Herman H. Hettler", a 210 foot steam barge, rests in massive pieces on a rock reef after it wrecked there in 1926.
